"Conspiracy": Is Satan Signature In The Word Of God

"Conspiracy Theory": Is An Invention By
The Devil

What exactly is a conspiracy? It is <u>a secret plan</u>, <u>involving the</u> <u>cooperation of two or more people</u>, in some cases "evil spirits" that seeks to accomplish something illegal, evil or wrong based on the Scriptures.

The bible warns us according to Luke 8:17 For <u>nothing is secret</u> that will not be revealed, nor anything hidden that will not be known and come to light. Also read Mark 4:22

The bible also reminds us that we have a duty to expose evil and to have no fellowship with those who practice wickedness. **Ephesians 5:11** *And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them.*

The word "conspiracy" or "conspired" is mentioned in the Old Testament thirty times! Note the following examples in scripture.

Here are some examples of <u>conspiracies</u> in the bible. <u>Conspiracies</u> have existed for ages, but unfortunately in "modern" society the word "conspiracy" is mocked and does not exist. In a world that is rule by Satan and his minions, conspiracy has been replaced as "theories", which are not based on facts or evidence. Here is biblical proof that conspiracies are real and does exist. The devil is a liar and <u>John 8:44</u> tell us that he is the father of lies! According to scripture it was Satan who plotted to take over the Most High God kingdom according to <u>Isaiah</u> 14:13-14: For thou hast said in thine heart, <u>I will ascend</u> into heaven, <u>I</u> will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

Genesis 37:18-20

And when they saw him afar off, even before he came near them, they <u>conspired</u> against him to kill him. And they said to one another, 'Behold, this dreamer comes. Therefore come now, and let us kill him

Judges 16:5 (A conspiracy is plotted against Samson by the Philistines using a prostitute name Delilah whom Samson find appealing)

Lure him and see where his great strength lies, and by what means we may prevail against him, so that we may tie him to afflict him. And each one of us will give you eleven hundred pieces of silver

Psalm 64:2

Hide me from the secret counsel of evildoers,

From the tumult of those who do iniquity,

Jeremiah 11:9

Then the Lord said to me, "A <u>conspiracy</u> has been found among the men of Judah and among the inhabitants of Jerusalem."

Matthew 12:14

But the Pharisees went out and <u>conspired</u> against Him, (Yeshua) as to how they might destroy Him.

Acts 23:12

When it was day, the Jews formed a <u>conspiracy</u> and bound themselves under an oath, saying that they would neither eat nor drink until they had killed Paul.

Psalm 83:5

For they have **conspired** together with one mind;

Against You they make a covenant:

2 Samuel 15:31

Now someone told David, saying, "Ahithophel is among the <u>conspirators</u> with Absalom." And David said, "O Lord, I pray, make the counsel of Ahithophel foolishness."

Ezekiel 22:25

There is a <u>conspiracy</u> of her prophets in her midst like a roaring lion tearing the prey. They have devoured lives; they have taken treasure and precious things; they have made many widows in the midst of her.

Acts 9:23

When many days had elapsed, the Jews <u>plotted</u> together to do away with him,

Psalm 21:11

Though they intended evil against You

And devised a **plot**,

They will not succeed.

Jeremiah 12:6

For even your brothers and the household of your father,

Even they have dealt <u>treacherously</u> (unforeseen or hidden hazards; dangerous or deceptive) with you,

Even they have cried aloud after you.

Do not believe them, although they may say nice things to you.

2 Samuel 15:12

And Absalom sent for Ahithophel the Gilonite, David's counselor, from his city Giloh, while he was offering the sacrifices. And the **conspiracy** was strong, for the people increased continually with Absalom.

Psalm 83:3

They make shrewd plans against Your people,

And conspire together against Your treasured ones.

Genesis 37:18

When they saw him from a distance and before he came close to them, they <u>plotted</u> against him to put him to death.

1 Peter 3:14

But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, you are blessed. And do not fear their intimidation, and do not be troubled,

Psalm 31:20

You hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the <u>conspiracies</u> of man;

You keep them secretly in a shelter from the strife of tongues.

Amos 7:10

Then Amaziah, the priest of Bethel, sent word to Jeroboam king of Israel, saying, "Amos has conspired against you in the midst of the house of Israel; the land is unable to endure all his words.

2 Kings 21:23

The servants of Amon <u>conspired</u> against him and killed the king in his own house.

2 Kings 14:19

They <u>conspired</u> against him in Jerusalem, and he fled to Lachish; but they sent after him to Lachish and killed him there.

Nehemiah 4:8

All of them <u>conspired</u> together to come and fight against Jerusalem and to cause a disturbance in it.

Psalm 56:5

All day long they distort my words;

All their thoughts are against me for evil.

2 Chronicles 24:21

So they <u>conspired</u> against him and at the command of the king they stoned him to death in the court of the house of the Lord.

1 Kings 16:9

His servant Zimri, commander of half his chariots, <u>conspired</u> against him. Now he was at Tirzah drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza, who was over the household at Tirzah.

Daniel 6:4

Then the commissioners and satraps began trying to find a **ground of accusation** against Daniel in regard to government affairs; but they could find no ground of accusation or evidence of corruption, inasmuch as he was faithful, and no negligence or corruption was to be found in him.

Jeremiah 11:19

But I was like a gentle lamb led to the slaughter;

And I did not know that they had devised plots against me, saying,

"Let us destroy the tree with its fruit,

And let us cut him off from the land of the living,

That his name be remembered no more."

Matthew 21:38-41

But when the vine-growers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir; come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.' "They took him, and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. "Therefore when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinegrowers?

Matthew 26:3-4

Then the chief priests and the elders of the people were gathered together in the court of the high priest, named Caiaphas; and they plotted together to seize Jesus by stealth and kill Him.

Acts 18:12

But while Gallio was proconsul of Achaia, the Jews with one accord rose up against Paul and brought him before the judgment seat (Court).

Acts 23:12-15

When it was day, the Jews formed a **conspiracy** and bound themselves under an oath, saying that they would neither eat nor drink until they had killed Paul. There were more than forty who formed this **plot**. They came to the chief priests and the elders and said, "We have bound ourselves under a solemn oath to taste nothing until we have killed Paul

Jeremiah 18:18

Then they said, "Come and let us <u>devise plans against</u> Jeremiah. Surely the law is not going to be lost to the priest, nor counsel to the sage, nor the divine word to the prophet! Come on and <u>let us strike at him with our tongue</u>, and let us give no heed to any of his words."

1 Esdras 5:73

And by their <u>secret plots</u>, and popular persuasions and commotions, they hindered the finishing of the building all the time that king Cyrus lived: so they were hindered from building for the space of two years, until the reign of Darius.

The Bible tells us that the plots of the wicked will return upon their own heads.

Psalm 7:14-16:

"Behold, the wicked brings forth iniquity; yes, he conceives trouble and brings forth falsehood. He made a pit and dug it out, and has fallen into the ditch which he made. His trouble shall return upon his

own head, and his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown."

Deuteronomy 32:35

Vengeance is Mine, and recompense; <u>Their foot shall slip in due time</u>; <u>For the day of their calamity</u> is at hand, And the things to come hasten <u>upon them.</u>

Psalms 73:-17-18

Until I went into the sanctuary of God; Then I understood their end. <u>Surely You set them in slippery places</u>; <u>You cast them down to destruction</u>. Oh, how <u>they are brought to desolation</u>, as in a moment! <u>They are utterly</u> consumed with terrors.

Jeremiah 23:12

Therefore their way shall be to them Like slippery ways; In the darkness they shall be driven on And fall in them; For I will bring disaster on them, The year of their punishment," says the Lord.

Galatians 6:7-8 tells us:

The Parable Of The Sower (A Story Told By Jesus)

Matthew 13:1-23

1 That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. 2 Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. 3 Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. 4 As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. 5 Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. 6 But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. 7 Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. 8 Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. 9 Whoever has ears, let them hear." 10 The disciples came to him and asked, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?" 11 He replied, "Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. 12 Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. 13 This is why I speak to them in parables: "Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand. 14 In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: "You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. 15 For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.' 16 But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear. 17 For truly I tell you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear but did not hear it. 18 "Listen then to what the parable of the sower means: 19 When anyone hears the

message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path. 20 The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. 21 But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away. 22 The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful. 23 But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

Job 4:8

"According to what I have seen, those who plow iniquity

And those who sow trouble harvest it.

Proverbs 11:18

The wicked earns deceptive wages,

But he who sows righteousness gets a true reward.

James 3:18

And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.
